PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 86 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused Rank not known, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Woman Act, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 06.03.2021 the defacto complainant's husband namely Senthilkumar was waiting for pick up his wife in Thoivalai Taluk Office. At that time, one Prasath, who is working as Village Administrative Officer in Killiyur, has wordy quarreled with the defacto complainant's husband, where by, the defacto complainant's husband was assaulted by



Prasath along with his colleague/petitioners herein. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocent and a false case has been foisted against them.

4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) would submit that this is the case in counter.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Boothapandy, Kanniyakumari District on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a) the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(c) the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
