Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the petition filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to extend the time for produce sureties, relating to the Anticipatory Bail granted to the petitioner by this Hon'ble court in Crl.OP.(MD). No.468 of 2020 dated 22.01.2021 in Crime No.995 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent.

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.R.ALAGUMANI, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.M.V.CHANDRASEKARAN, Government Advocate(Criminal Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

This petition is filed to extend the time limit of the petitioner's surrender and execute sureties in Crl.O.P(MD)No.468 of 2021, dated 22.01.2021.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD).No.468 of 2021 and one of the condition is that the petitioner has to execute two sureties within a period of two weeks. In the mean while, the petitioner was detained by the Executive Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner of Police, Trichy, vide his order in M.C.No.363 of 2020, dated 02.02.2021. In view of the same, the petitioner was unable to come out on bail and to execute sureties. He further submitted that now the proceedings in M.C.No.363 of 2020 has been set aside. Hence, he seeks extension of time.



3.Heard the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) for the respondent.

4.Considering the reasons stated in the petition, this petition is ordered and the time for surrender by the petitioner before the concerned Court and executing the sureties is extended by two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which the anticipatory bail already granted by this Court shall stand cancelled. It is made clear that no further extension will be granted and if the petitioner fails to comply with the order within the stipulated period, the respondent police shall secure the petitioners and proceed in accordance with law.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.
