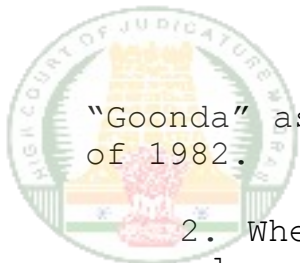

This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the wife of the detenu, namely, Korasekar @ Sekar, S/o.Govindaraj, aged about 46 years, challenging the detention order in C.O.C.No.4 of 2021, dated 22.02.2021, passed by the second respondent, branding him as



"Goonda" as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Standing counsel appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.1730, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XV) Department, dated 15.04.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.

3. Recording the above submission, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
