2. Recording the same, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.

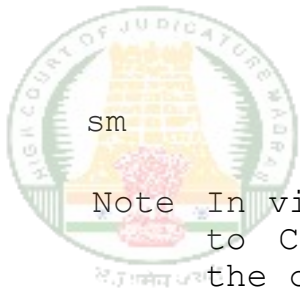
