Prayer in CRL MP(MD).No.2256 of 2021:-

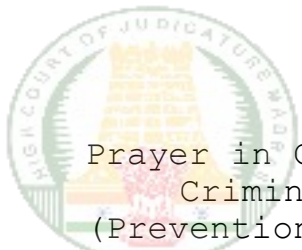
