3.Recording the submission, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

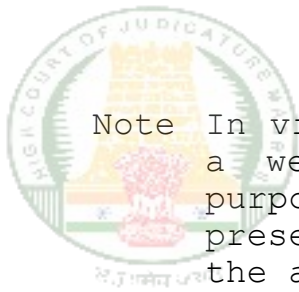
