3.Recording the submissions of the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

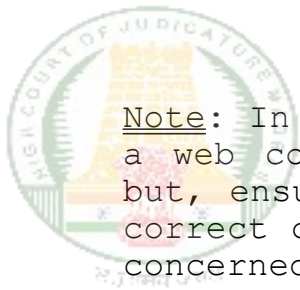
