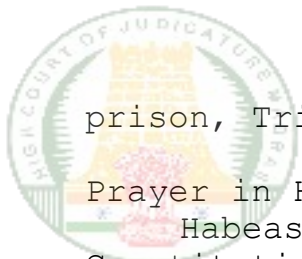

Habeas Corpus Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India,praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court will be pleased To issue a WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS or any other appropriate order or direction in the nature of writ calling for the entire records relating to the impugned order of the detention dated 19.07.2020 in PD.No. 20/2020 passed by the 2nd respondent herein and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to set forth the detainee Mr.C.Thamilarasan, S/o.Chandrasekaran, aged about 66 years, now confined in central prison, Trichirappalli set at him at liberty.
