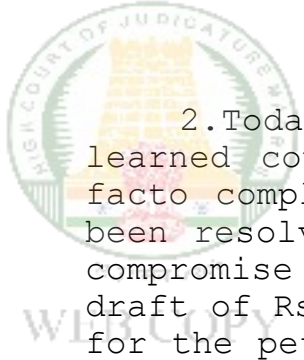
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.8 of 2020 on the file of the
Respondent Police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/A1 to A5, who apprehend arrest at the hands of
the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under
Sections 294(b), 420 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.8 of 2020, seek
anticipatory bail.



2.Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, both the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the de-facto complainant submitted that the issue between the parties had been resolved amicably and entered into compromise. A copy of the compromise memo, dated 22.07.2021 is filed along with copy of demand draft of Rs.4,00,000/-. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the de-facto complainant had withdrawn the complaint given before the respondent police station.

3.In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, this Court is of the considered view that no further order is necessary in this case.

4.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is closed and the joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of this order.
