Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 1 and 2 to conduct detailed enquiry and permit the petitioner to enter into her own property with necessary police protection comprised in Town Survey No.3534/40, Block 23B, 4th Ward, Mani Nagar Street, Thoothukudi Town, Thoothukudi District as per the sale deed dated 06.09.2019 based upon the petitioner's representation dated 09.02.2021.

2.The main grievance of the petitioner is that though a decree was passed in his favour in O.S.No.16 of 2016 and consequently, sale deed was also executed by the learned Subordinate Judge, Thoothukudi, the private respondents are preventing him from entering into the property purchased by him. Therefore, he sought for police protection in this regard.



3.Mr.S.Chandrasekar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, who accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2, on instructions, would submit that the representation submitted by the petitioner was registered in CSR.No.97 of 2021 and posted for enquiry.
