submitted that the petitioner is a juvenile.

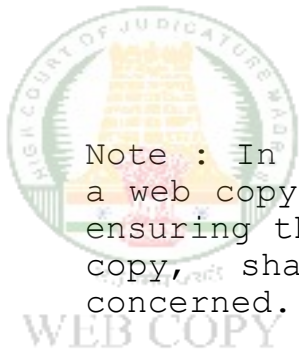
3.Since the petitioner is a juvenile and as such this petition
