To call for the records of the judgment dated 09.07.2015 in Crl.A.No.57 of 2013 by the learned Principal District Sessions Judge, Theni confirming the conviction and sentence of imprisonment for 6 months Simple Imprisonment and to pay a sum of Rs.3,000/- in default to pay one month Simple Imprisonment for an offence under Sec. 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Court(FTC) Uthamapalayam in S.T.C.No.9 of 2012 by the judgment dated 17.09.2013 and Set-aside the Judgments of the Courts below and acquit the petitioner.

Order : These petitions coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petitions filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.A.P.MUTHUPANDIAN, Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions and respondent not appeared either in person or by an advocate, While admitting the Criminal Revisions, the court made the following order:-
