It is stated that the respondents have preferred appeals against the order of the writ court and notice has been ordered therein to the respondents in C.M.P.(MD).Nos.1578 & 1569 of 2021. When the Honourable Division Bench has taken cognizance of the matter, it would not be appropriate to simultaneously adjudicate the contempt petition. Hence, the contempt petitions stand closed. However, in case, the petitioners are of the view that the disobedience continues even after the final disposal of the writ appeals itself, it is open to them to exercise his rights with



regard to such disobedience, in accordance with law.
