ORDER

But so far, the respondents did not file the final report and prayed for a direction to file the final report within the time frame.

The matter involved is a business transaction and the records are necessary and prayed three months time to file the final report.

4.In the above circumstances, the petitioner is hereby directed to cooperate for the investigation and to produce documents as and when required by the respondents. Thereby, the respondents 1 and 2 are hereby directed to investigate the matter and to file a report within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
