Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the Principal Sessions Judge, Karur (Special Court for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act Cases, Karur Division), to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender in Crime No.137 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioners are the Accused 2 to 4 in Crime No.137 of 2021 of Kulithalai Police Station, Karur, and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(i) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities)



2.The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the Principal Sessions Judge, Karur (Special Court for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act Cases, Karur Division), to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant / victim.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application on the same day, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the Principal Sessions Judge, Karur (Special Court for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act Cases, Karur Division), within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
