The prayer in the Habeas Corpus Petition is to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to produce the Petitioner's daughter namely, Gayathri, aged 23 years, who is now in the illegal custody of the third respondent, before this Court and set her at liberty.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials placed before this Court.

3.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the detinue appeared before this Court along with the third respondent. On enquiry, the detinue would state that she married the third respondent on 21.03.2021. She further stated that she is not willing to go with the Petitioner and that she is a major. Hence, we find no merit in the Habeas Corpus Petition.



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4. Accordingly, the Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed.
