3.Considering the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the second respondent is directed to dispose of C.S.R.No.204 of 2021, based on findings and on merits, after giving notice and sufficient opportunity to the respondents 3 to 7, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.



4. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
