Prayer in CRL OP(MD) . 16216 of 2019 :

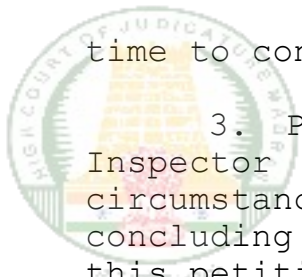
