2.The present petition filed by the petitioner is to direct the learned II Additional District and Sessions Judge, Tirunelveli (PCR Act Cases) to accept the surrender of the petitioner and also

i.The petitioner should appear before the learned II Additional District and Sessions Judge, Tirunelveli (PCR Act Cases) within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

ii.On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
