3.Recording the said submission, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

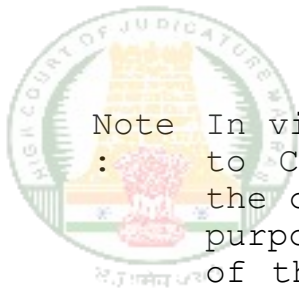
