ORDER

3.In the circumstances, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent to follow the guidelines issued in the decisions in **D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal** reported in **AIR (1997) SC 610** and **Lalita kumari vs. Government of Uttarpradesh and Others** reported in **AIR 2014 SC 187**, if any complaint is lodged against the present petitioner and further the second respondent should not interfere in any civil dispute.
