3.Since the fourth respondent is a senior citizen aged about 76 years, the third respondent is directed to dispose of the petition, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order/uploading of this order, keeping in mind the law set out in Section 21 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 and the guidelines issued in the decision in **D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal** reported in **AIR (1997) SC 610**.

4.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
