PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime no. 3 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A.1 who apprehends arrest for the offences under Sections 406, 420 r/w 34 I.P.C., in Crime number 3 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

3. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/A.1 submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the investigation is pending and all the other three accused are absconding.



5. It is seen from the submissions made that the petitioner/A.1 along with other accused said to have received a sum of Rs.78,18,000/- on the promise of getting a post of Chief Administrative Officer to one Gnanasekaran, son of the defacto complainant, who is MBA graduate in Medical Management. The FIR reveals that many amounts have been transferred to the account of this petitioner through banking transactions.

6. Considering the seriousness of the offences alleged to have been committed by this petitioner along with other accused and also huge money transactions received by the petitioner through his bank account, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
