This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the detenu, namely, Kartheeswaran, S/o.Jeyapandi, aged about 27 years, challenging the detention order in B.C.D.F.G.I.S.S.S.V.No.1 of 2021, dated 21.01.2021, passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Goonda" as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Standing counsel appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.1700, Home, Prohibition & Excise (IX) Department, dated



15.04.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.
