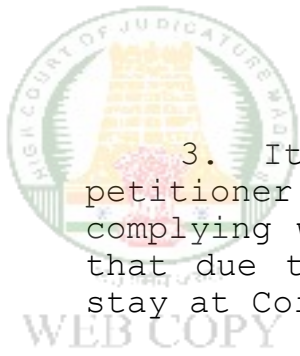

2.The petitioner is A1 in S.C.No.50 of 2014 on the file of the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Dindigul. While granting suspension of sentence to this petitioner, this Court on 25.01.2021 directing him to stay at Coimbatore and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Coimbatore, at 10.30 a.m., on all working days, until further orders.



3. It is the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner Mr.N.Ananthapadmanabhan, that the petitioner has been complying with the condition from 02.02.2021. It is also submitted that due to the pandemic situation, the petitioner is not able to stay at Coimbatore to comply with the condition.
