Heard Mrs.L.Victoria Gowri, Learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner and Mr.C.M.Mari Chelliah Prabhu, Learned Additional Government Pleader, who takes notice for the Respondents, and perused the materials placed on record, apart from the pleadings of the parties.



2. Though the Writ Petition has been filed seeking for direction to the Second Respondent to grant incentive increment to the Petitioner for acquiring B.Lit. and B.Ed. Degrees along with other consequential benefits, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner would be satisfied if her representations dated 27.10.2020 and 01.02.2021 made to the Second Respondent in that regard is disposed within a time frame stipulated by this Court and would confine her claim to that extent. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner has also filed a memo to that effect.

3. Having regard to the aforesaid submission made, this Court without expressing any view on the correctness or entitlement of the claim made by the Petitioner, requires the Second Respondent to dispassionately consider the claim made by the Petitioner in her representations dated 27.10.2020 and 01.02.2021, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to her and pass reasoned orders on merits and in accordance with law, communicate the decision taken under written acknowledgment and file report of such compliance before the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court by 30.06.2021.

4. In fine, the Writ Petition is disposed on the aforesaid terms. No costs.
