Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.2946 of 2021:-

Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, praying this Court to Extend time for two weeks to his surrender and file bail application before the Principal Sessions Judge Cum PCR Judge, Ramanathapuram in Crl.OP.(MD).No.5334 of 2020 in Cr.No.100 of 2020 on 14.5.2020.

Prayer in CRL OP(MD).No.5334 of 2020 :

Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, praying this Court to direct the Principal Sessions Judge cum PCR Judge, Ramanathapuram to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the very same day of the surrender and to release them on bail on the every same day itself, in connection with the FIR in Crime No.100 of 2020 on the file of second respondent police.

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is filed seeking extension of time for surrendering before the trial Court as per the order of this Court, dated 14.05.2020 in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.5334 of 2020.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he was not in a position to surrender before the concerned Court within the time stipulated by this Court and seeks further time to surrender.

3.Considering the request made by the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court, on or before 23.04.2021, failing which, the order passed by this Court, shall stand automatically cancelled, without further reference to this Court.

4.Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is ordered.
