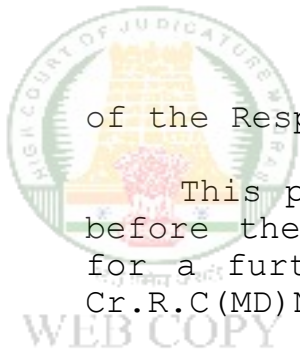
PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No.337 of 2021 IN CRL RC(MD) No.22 of 2021:
