Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Ramanathapuram to consider the petitioner bail application on the day of their surrender in crime No.46 of 2021 on the file of the Parthipanoor Police Station, Paramakudi Sub-Division, Ramanathapuram District.

ORDER

The petitioner is the first Accused in Crime No.46 of 2021 of Parthipanoor Police Station, Paramakudi Sub-Division, Ramanathapuram District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 294(b), 323, 355, 506(1) of IPC, Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2) (Va) of the Schedule Caste and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Amendment Act, 2015).

2. The present petition filed by the petitioner is to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Ramanathapuram, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3. Mr.K.Suyambulinga Bharathi, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined



to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioner should appear before the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Ramanathapuram, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
