DECREE:-

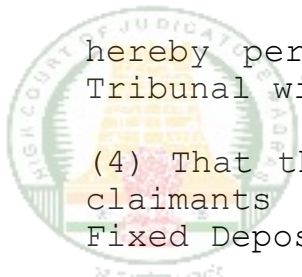

(1) That the award passed by the the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (III Additional District and Sessions Judge) Thanjavur at Pattukottai dated 11.01.2018, made in M.C.O.P.No.146 of 2016, be and hereby is confirmed and the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is dismissed,

(2) That the Appeallant/Insurance Company be and hereby is directed to deposit the entire award amount with accrued interests and costs if not already deposited, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the Judgment, herein,

(5) That there be no costs in this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.
