3.The learned Standing Counsel for State Government submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly.

4.Taking into consideration of the submissions made by both the counsels, the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.3485 of 2020 in Crl.A(MD)No.90 of 2020 dated 14.07.2020 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Court once in two months i.e., on the first working day of every two month at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
