This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed by this Court, dated 17.02.2021 in CrI.M.P(MD)No.7406 of 2020 in CrI.A (MD)No.132 of 2020.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials placed before this Court.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner would state that the Petitioner has been complying with the conditions from 01.03.2021 regularly. In view of the pandemic situation, it is very difficult for the Petitioner to stay at Ramanathapuram to comply with the conditions imposed by this Court.

4.Mr.S.Chandrasekar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent, on instructions, would state that the Petitioner is a native of Thanjavur District and he is now staying at Ramanathapuram to comply with the conditions.

5.In the light of the above submissions made on either side, the original condition imposed by this Court is modified, directing the Petitioner to appear before the Committal Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

6.This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is ordered accordingly.

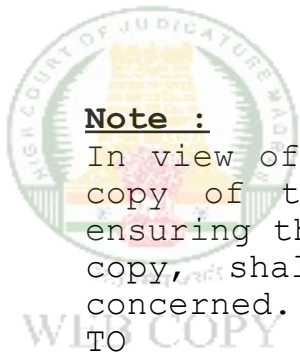
