**O R D E R**

This petition has been filed to quash the Crime No.157 of 2015 pending on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thadikombu Police Station, Dindigul District, dated 19.4.2015.

2.The petitioners and the defacto complainant are the neighbours. The contention of the petitioners and the first respondent is that based on the complaint, lodged by the first respondent, the second respondent registered First Information Report, in Crime No. 157 of 2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b) & 326 (A) IPC, against the petitioners.

3.The further contention of the petitioners is that they compromised the issue with the first respondent amicably. A joint memo of compromise was filed, which has been duly signed by the petitioners and the first respondent and also by their respective counsels.

before this Court along with their counsels and also produced their Aadhar cards. They were also identified by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) and Mr.S.SundararajV.Mohammed Khan, the Special Sub-Inspector of Police, Thadikombu Police Station, Dindigul District. Both the parties were enquired by me and they accepted the terms of compromise. Hence, the Compromise Memo is recorded.

5.Considering the totality of the circumstances, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners and also in view of the joint compromise memo, dated 08.04.2021, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the matter pending. Hence, all further proceedings in Crime No.157 of 2015 pending on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thadikombu Police Station, Dindigul District, is quashed and the compromise memo is recorded.

6.In the result, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and the entire proceedings in Crime No.157 of 2015 pending on the file of the Inspector of Police, Thadikombu Police Station, Dindigul District, is hereby quashed in respect of the petitioners and the terms of joint compromise memo shall form part of this order.
