3. This petition is dismissed for default.

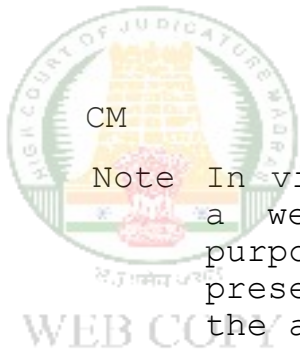
