Prayer in WP(MD). 1441 of 2020 :

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 18 percent per annum, for the period of delay from 01-06-2018 to 21-09-2019, in paying the amounts paid towards the terminal and pension benefits of the petitioner namely EPF Employee's Contribution, Gratuity, Encashment of Earned/Sick Leaves and Commuted Value of pension, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Honourable Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.
