3. Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

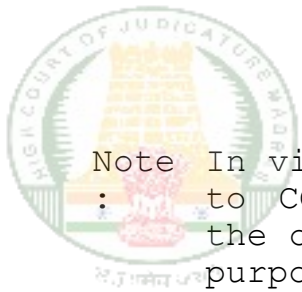
