The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners seek permission of this Court to withdraw this petition appearing through video conferencing.

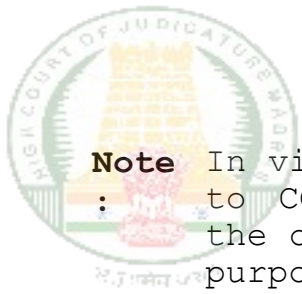
2.In view of the same, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
