As of now, she wants to join her mother, the petitioner herein.

2. We have also counselled her about her responsibility and as to the avenues available to resolve matrimonial problems. She appears to have understood what we have said and she has also completed her Diploma in Computer Applications.



3. Hence, we find that there is no unlawful detention. Accordingly, the Habeaus Corpus petition is dismissed.
