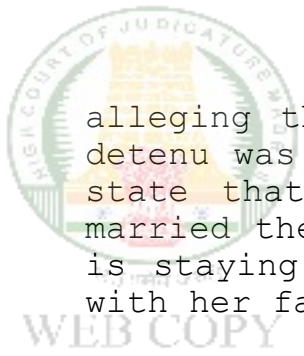

Now she is staying with the third respondent and she is not willing to go with her father.
