



period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order along with a bond for a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only) with two sureties for a like sum.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner purchased the vehicle as second hand in the year 2011 and he is the only breadwinner of his family. Hence, he prays this Court to modify the amount as Rs.25,000/-.

3.It is seen from the records that the type of Car is Mahendra Logan DLX Car). Therefore, the condition imposed on the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) is correct and it does not warrant any interference and the criminal miscellaneous petition stands dismissed.
