**Prayer :** Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the learned District and Sessions Judge, PCR Cases, Tiruchirapalli to consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on the same day of surrender in Crime No.13 of 2021 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police. **ORDER**

The petitioners are the accused 1 to 4 in Crime No.13 of 2021 of All Women Police Station, Srirengam, Trichy District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 498(A) and 506(1) of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 1989.

2.The present petition filed by the petitioners are to direct the learned District and Sessions Judge, PCR Cases,



Tiruchirapalli, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.R.Anandharaj, learned Government Additional Public Prosecutor accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the learned District and Sessions Judge, PCR Cases, Tiruchirapalli, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

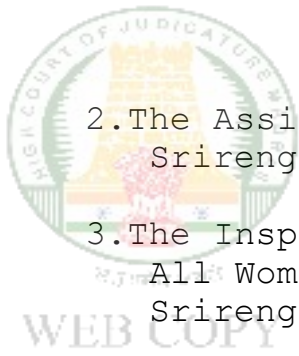
