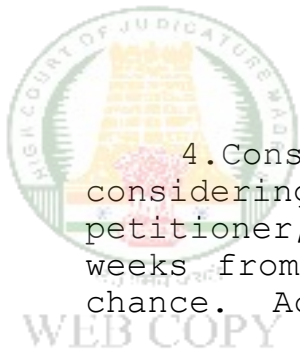

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was not able to arrange sureties and execute the bail bond within a stipulated time as ordered by this Court. Hence, he prays to grant further time to execute the sureties.
