This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the daughter of the detainee, namely, Anna Pillai, wife of Sivaraj, aged 37/2021 years, challenging the detention order in P.D.No.39 of 2021, dated 24.03.2021 passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Drug Offender" as contemplated under Section 2(e) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Standing Counsel for the State appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.2080, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XV) Department, dated 04.05.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.
