PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.52 of 2021 on the file of
the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for
the alleged offences punishable under Sections 120(B), 201, 403,
406, 408, 420, 465, 468, 471 and 506(i) of IPC and Section 65 of the
Information Technology Act, 2020 in Crime No.52 of 2021 on the file
of the respondent police, the petitioner has come forward with this
petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused in this case
had cheated the de-facto complainant to the tune of several crores.
Very many persons involved in the commission of offencely, forging
the documents and misappropriation. This petitioner is also
involved in the commission of offence.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner was retired Headmistress and she has no way involved in
the commission of offence. He would further submit that A-1, A-2, A-
5 and A-3 were arrested and released on bail by the Principal
District Judge, Madurai in Crl.M.P.Nos.2208 and 2209 of 2021 on
17.03.2021 and A9, A13, A14 and A15 were granted anticipatory bail
by this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.3159 of 2021 on 01.04.2021.
Therefore, she seeks anticipatory bail.



4. The learned Government Advocate (criminal side), strongly opposed this petition on the ground that the investigation is pending.

5. Taking note of the fact that the petitioner is not a prime accused and also the fact that the co-accused were already granted bail and anticipatory bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or her appearance, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumangalam, Madurai District, and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that,

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar cards or Bank pass Books to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily, at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and

(f) if the accused/petitioner thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
