Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondents 1 and 2 and the learned counsel appearing for respondents 4 and 5.

2. Considering the nature of relief to be granted, issuance of notice to respondents 4 and 5 is dispensed with.

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3. The fourth respondent is none other than the son of the petitioner. The petitioner alleges that he is being threatened and disturbed by the fourth respondent. It is further stated that the fifth respondent who is an ex-councillor is supporting the fourth respondent.

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4. I do not want to enter into the factual controversies. The provisions of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act contemplate that the local police must act in such a manner so as to give a feeling of safety to the senior citizens. The Government has also framed statutory rules in this regard. The third respondent is directed to dispose of the petitioner's representation on merits and in accordance with law in the light of the statutory scheme as mentioned above.

5. This criminal original petition is disposed of accordingly.
