6. Considering the limited relief sought for, without advertng to the merits of the case, the third respondent is directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner, dated 19.03.2021, in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
