2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner represented that this Court allowed the Criminal Revision Case in Crl.R.C(MD) No.705 of 2020, dated 21.12.2020 with certain conditions. Therefore, he seeks to extend the time for a period of one month for complying with the condition.
