This Criminal Original Petition has been filed for quashment of FIR in Cr.No.8 of 2019 which was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 494 and 506(1) I.P.C.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the first respondent would submit that the investigation was completed and during the course of the investigation, both the parties were appeared. Since the matrimonial dispute between the husband and wife, they have stated that the entire compromise in the presence of the elders at village can dissolved the marriage amicably. So, based upon the



compromise, there has been a compromise between the parties. Further action has been dropped on 21.01.2021. It was presented before the concerned Court and also notice has been served upon the defacto-complainant.

3.This Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
