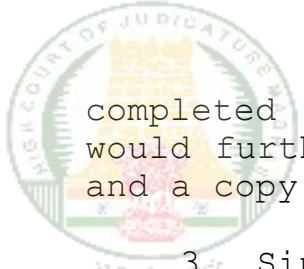

If the petitioner is aggrieved by the contents of final report, she can work out her remedy before appropriate Court. With the above liberty, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
