The learned Government Advocate would submit that based upon the complaint given by the second respondent, investigation has been undertaken and during the course of investigation, it was found that the complaint has been given out of mistake of facts, since the Power of Attorney, which was executed in his favour is



not valid in law. On coming to know the above fact, the second respondent gave a statement that no further action required on his complaint. On the basis of the statement given by the second respondent, further action was dropped on 16.03.2020. RCS notice was also served upon the petitioner.
